

PSY 402, 403, 404 SEMINAR COURSES

DESCRIPTION: Examination in depth of specific topics in psychology at the graduate level. These seminars vary from year to year in terms of the number given, the topics, and the restrictions on enrolment. Students must get prior consent from the instructor of the graduate seminar they are interested in taking and submit this consent in writing to the department at which time you will be enrolled for undergraduate credit.

Undergraduate students who are given permission to take a seminar at the graduate level (offered through the Dept. of Psychology Graduate Program) enrol into one of PSY 402, 403, or 404, depending on how many have already been taken by the student (i.e., if PSY 402 has already been taken, student would be enrolled in PSY 403, etc.). The listings for these courses are generally available in August from the Graduate Administrator, and enrolment starts in September. The instructor of the course will need to give you permission first, although the Graduate Administrator would need to be consulted, as well. Undergraduates would not be able to enrol until graduate students have had the opportunity to enrol first. Please note that enrolment is not guaranteed. Please have a back-up course planned in the event that you are not given permission or the course is full. Once permission has been granted and open space confirmed, the Undergraduate Administrator will need to be sent an email from the instructor requesting the student's enrolment with the following info: Student name, student ID, graduate course code and term, course subtitle. Student will then be enrolled into the UG course code.
